

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MiCollab Desktop Client Features – Handoff Call

Introduction This quick reference guide provides instructions on how to use the MiCollab Desktop client to handoff an active call to another device.

Handoff to Another Device To handoff your active call to another device, perform the following procedure within the Call window.

Note: Device must be configured on MiCollab.

Step	Action
1	Click Handoff 
2	In the Handoff to dialog box, click appropriate device 

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

